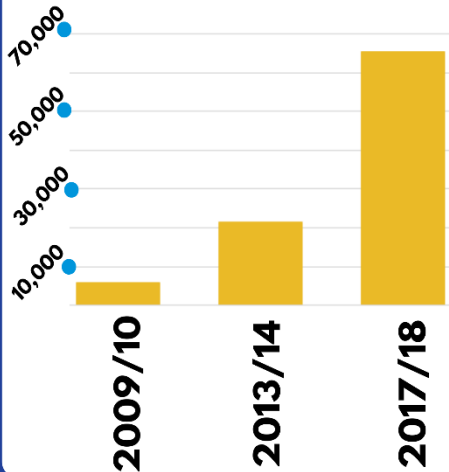


# YOUR IMPACT
